Please can I remind you all about **school policy regarding uniform** — children should be wearing black shoes/trainers with their school uniform navy shorts, trousers, skirts or dresses. (If Y6 need new trousers, they can wear grey ready for Kingdown!) Green polos and navy sweatshirt. On PE days, navy shorts, tracksuit or leggings with a navy t-shirt and burgundy hoodie or their school sweatshirt. **Long hair should be tied back every day; small stud earrings only and simple, plain hair bands. Small wrist watches** only, if necessary! Children should have a **bookbags**, 1 small keyring only please, to carry their reading book and yellow reading records. These yellow reading records should be recording their daily reading at home. I cannot stress enough the impact of regular reading. Please do speak to your class teacher if choosing the correct books is something your child struggles with. I will be monitoring children's daily reading to see if some children would benefit from some additional time and support, especially in KS2. If you would like to volunteer time to hear readers on a weekly basis, please do speak to your class teacher. If you are needing any support with providing correct uniform, do talk to me! **Name everything!**
