This is within this document, about Penalty Notices ... *A penalty notice is an alternative to you being taken to court by the local authority. If your child has 10 or more sessions of unauthorised absence in a 10 school week period, the school will inform our Education Welfare Service who may issue a penalty notice for each child to each parent. If you get a second fine in 3 years it will be £160. If your child is off school 3 or more times within the 3 years you will not be fined but may be taken to court.*

It's been a lovely week back, starting Term 6 – although what happened to the weather? Children may need coats at the moment but classrooms are warm so unlikely to need both! Please still do apply sun cream and have hats because when the sun does come out it is really hot!

Next week, Year 6 are doing a morning of Junior Young Citizen – Children will interact with a number of simulated life-like scenarios during the event, which will raise their awareness of the contribution they can make in preventing crime and increasing their own safety.
