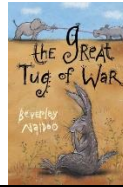





5	Red vowels and blue consonants.	
6	Dot the letters.	

**You could also try:** Apps like the Spelling Shed; typing the words onto a computer or tablet; ask someone to write the word in three different ways, with only one correct spelling; then mark them, finding the right word and correcting the misspelled words.
