This is within this document, about Penalty Notices ... *A penalty notice is an alternative to you being taken to court by the local authority. If your child has 10 or more sessions of unauthorised absence in a 10 school week period, the school will inform our Education Welfare Service who may issue a penalty notice for each child to each parent. If you get a second fine in 3 years it will be £160. If your child is off school 3 or more times within the 3 years you will not be fined but may be taken to court.*

Due to the weather last week, we will finish our Sports Day this afternoon – it will be hot but will be the perfect finish for the term. Please park carefully around the village ensuring that ambulances, fire engines and vans can get access around the village.
