POWER PROJECTS have been shared with children today. Can I ask that Potters are patient as theirs should be ready mid-week next week. We will be repeating our fabulous School Museum Day on 3rd July.

May Fayre – What a lovely day last Saturday. A huge thank you to Gussie and her small team of organisers who pulled the whole event together. Also, to anyone who ran a stall, helped set up or put it all away again, thank you - it really made a huge difference and was very much appreciated.

This week and weekend, staff/friends have had another big push to prepare for **KS2 to be reorganised** within our KS1 building. All children have been told about their class changes for during the building work and know what the plans will be!

A stud wall in Thatchers will separate Thatchers and Foresters classes. Potters will remain where they are and Weavers will be using the staff room and library; Spinners and Spin Off.

When we have closed the carpark fully and the builders are in situ, we will do stop and drop and children will walk along the wall to the main entrance; there will be additional adults on duty to support this initially.

At home times, in the first instance we will be staying with the same timings – Foresters and Thatchers will be collected from Thatchers playground. Potters and Weavers from Potters playground.

I urge you all, where possible, to try to park completely away from school and walk further. Shearwater Car Park is just a short 15-minute walk away. If drop-off and collection causes too much congestion, I will review arrangements.

A reminder please – all children should wear correct school uniform – green polo shirts, navy trousers, shorts or skirts. Black shoes. PE kits - navy shirt and shorts and burgundy hoodie. Year 6 should also be following these rules but they can wear their leavers hoodie on PE days only. All long hair should be tied back.

I have arranged for an **Educational Psychologist** to come in and lead a Workshop for parents on **Emotion Coaching** on Wednesday 26th June at 2pm, to fit in with pick up at the end of the school day.

Teaching Assistants at Crockerton did this in January and found it very useful.

There will be a focus on the emotions children show and what they might be trying to tell us when they exhibit this behaviour. Then strategies we can all use to support children when they are overwhelmed and how to look after ourselves when dealing with this.
