To achieve this, we will...

- not hurt others physically
- not upset others
- respect each other and their belongings
- not exclude others from games
- use the word 'bullying' correctly
- always tell an adult if we are being bullied
- always tell an adult if someone else is being bullied
- treat everyone as Friends

What happens after you tell an adult:

- This adult will tell your teacher was is happening.
- •The adults will agree with you what needs to be done.
- The adults will speak to the person who has been bullying and upsetting you.
- Your teacher will speak to your parents too.
- •The adults will be the ones who deal with the bully and sort out the actions that need to be taken to stop the bully from being unkind again.
- They will also check with you that the bullying has stopped.
