Please can I politely ask that you check all correspondence before emailing and telephoning the office or myself, asking general questions. I am sometimes asked questions during Drop Off in the morning and do not always have the answer in my head!

Most questions that are being asked are either **on Dojo stories**, in the **Weekly Newsletter** (sent every Friday or available on the Website) or in the **Parent Handbook** that was sent out at the very beginning of this term. Staff do not check their emails or dojo messages in the evening. If it is an essential message, my email address is the best contact in the event of an emergency. Please do consider respectfully, what time emails are being sent.

Potters and Thatchers only - If your child would like a lunch please remember to order by 3pm on the Thursday of the previous week. Booking for the whole term is advised!

Late Club – this is on every day of the week; a few exceptions which will be shared in advance. On a Tuesday and a Friday, a PH Sport coach covers the sessions. Please ensure all payments are settled up regularly. If your child is late being collected and they attend Late Club, payment is still expected please. $\pounds 2$ per family.

PE Kit on PE Days — please follow the uniform guide. Navy shorts, leggings or joggers, navy T-shirt and school hoodie, or similar, with trainers, not PE daps.

Be Kind, Be Safe, Be Responsible are our School Rules that all children know and hear regularly. The choices they make around school always fit in with these. We spend a lot of time learning and understanding these rules as well as our Church School Values – **Friendship, Compassion, Respect, Perseverance and Trust.**

Child Protection is at the heart of everything we do at Crockerton. Every member of staff has training at the start of every year, as well as regular updates and opportunities throughout the year. Child Protection is everyone's responsibility. Sometimes, staff need to follow up on something that your child may say, or do, or has behaved in a way that has caused concern, during the school day. These issues are treated confidentially and to ensure that children are safe. I am the Designated Safeguard Lead, and will be informed of the staff concern. If I am not about Mrs Woodley is the Deputy Designated Lead. I appreciate it is not always easy but thank you in advance for your support, if issues arise.

As a Bank Holiday was announced for the State Funeral of Queen Elizabeth II, **school is closed on Monday**. Worships this week, have allowed the children to think further about The Queen's death. Yesterday we discussed our 'Hope for the Future' during this time of change... similar to the changes that they may have experienced in our school over the years as well as what we hope for in the future. The children's ideas were very thoughtful—hoping that King Charles III continues to serve our country with kindness, we hope he visits lots of places—including Crockerton and we hope that the new King will work hard for us. In school we have seen lots of pupils taking on new roles in school. Our Y6 Buddies have been fantastic helpers in Potters class; children have been helping at lunch time and there are new House Captains and Vices.
