With us all well settled into our new arrangements while we wait for our fabulous KS2 building to be ready, we have

upped our **health and safety and safeguarding** arrangements a little.

- 1. We have improved signage to ensure we can see where Emergency Exits have changed.
- 2. A fire practice was completed this week, based on our new classes everyone out in a fraction over 2 minutes.
- 3. Staff have been reminded that if children leave early or leave school for an appointment or sporting event that they need to be signed out by parents, or the register of those out of school is given to the office.
- 4. All staff have also been consulted about a new Lockdown policy this will be shared at FGB and teachers will then sensitively share procedures with the children. This policy is used if an incident was happening outside of school eg traffic concerns, a medical emergency, excessive smoke or if there was an intruder on the grounds etc
