






Ways to practise tricky words

1 Write a sentence containing the word.	Person <i>A person who never made a mistake never tried anything new.</i>
2 Find the word in a book.	
3 Steps – write the word adding a letter each time.	
4 Funcky letters.	
5 Red vowels and blue consonants.	aeiou words b c d f g h j k l m n p q r s t v w x y z
6 Dot the letters.	

You could also try: Apps like the Spelling Shed; typing the words onto a computer or tablet; ask someone to write the word in three different ways, with only one correct spelling; then mark them, finding the right word and correcting the misspelled words.
