In our **Worships** this week, we heard the Parable of the Butterfly. The children have been thinking about some of the struggles they are faced with, both in school and at home, and how these will make them stronger in the long run. Please do ask your child about the Butterfly, and ensure they understand the importance of persevering even if they feel challenged...
